The Year in Review

This has been a year for reviewing and gathering information for projects that may interest our members. The extension of the boundaries of the

State Historic District to include those areas, which in 1986 were not included, would make homes located in that area eligible for State and Local Tax credits. This area is north of 68th Street. It is not a simple process and the Board needs to know if there is an interest in making the extension happen.

The Board has discussed forming a 501 (c)(3) Foundation as a complement to NEHHPA. With this foundation, NEHHPA would be able to accept charitable contributions of either money or property and pursue other projects that would be beneficial to our neighborhood that would be too cumbersome or impossible for NEHHPA itself to do.

The Board is working with other organizations to develop new ways of conducting neighborhood home tours. These tours are a great way of promoting our neighborhood and showcasing the historic value of our neighborhood.

The Board is working to develop a new welcome to the neighborhood packet for those moving into the neighborhood who might not be aware of all that this neighborhood has to offer.

Losing a Good Friend

Howard Hodnett, a long time NEHHPA Member, passed away recently. Howard worked on preparing the application in 1986 for the State Historic District designation for our neighborhood which in the days before the internet was no easy task.
